SEMESTER COURSE FEES

Craft Training tuition for employees of **GBRIA/Industrial Contractors Council** members in good standing is \$140 per course per semester Not including Welding, which is \$80.00. Tuition for Pelican Chapter members is \$280 per course excluding welding which is \$600. Craft Training tuition for all other students is \$550.00 per course per semester and \$1200.00 for Welding. Tuition for Supervisory Training and Safety courses vary from these amounts, as indicated on the reverse page. Tuition may be paid with cash, money order, Credit Card or company check made payable to ABC. A separate application is needed for each course and payment is due with the application.

REFUNDS and CANCELLATIONS

You may cancel your application for a course no later than ten (10) Business days prior to the first day of class for a FULL refund.

Failure to Cancel before 10 days prior to start of class will result in a partial refund of \$40.00. Contact the ABC Training Center and a refund will be mailed to the student. If ABC cancels a course, a full refund, of the total Tuition amount will be issued.
